### Baseball Player of the Week

#### Sean Killeen, Trinity

(Senior, Catcher - Greenfield, Mass.)  
Killeen led the Bantams to their second-straight NESCAC title over the weekend, batting .636 (7-for-11) while posting a .733 on-base percentage and a 1.364 slugging mark. During Sunday's championship against Tufts, Killeen went 4-for-4 with two home runs - including a grand slam in the bottom of the 8th inning to put Trinity ahead 7-3 en route to the win. For the weekend, Killeen had two doubles, two home runs, four walks, and seven RBI.

### Baseball Pitcher of the Week

#### Jeremiah Bayer, Trinity

(Junior, RHP - Greenfield, Mass.)  
Bayer earned an 8-3 complete-game victory over Williams on Saturday morning during the 2009 NESCAC Baseball Championship, his lone appearance in the tournament. Over 9.0 IP, Bayer allowed three runs, none of which were earned, and five hits while giving up five walks and striking out six batters. He held the Ephs to a .167 batting average.

**Notes:** Trinity College successfully defended its conference title over the weekend at Williams by winning the 2009 NESCAC Baseball Championship. The Bantams became the first team in the NESCAC to win three league crowns. The tournament started off on Friday afternoon with Williams downing Tufts 18-5. The Ephs set championship records for runs and hits in a game, scoring 18 runs along with 23 hits. Williams senior Taylor Mikell went 4-for-4 with a triple, a walk and five RBI in the win. Down at Wahconah Park in Pittsfield, Mass., Trinity used timely hitting to get past Wesleyan 13-6. On Saturday, Tufts battled past Wesleyan 15-10 and eliminated the Cardinals. Trailing 9-8 in the bottom of the sixth, the Jumbos scored six runs before adding four more in the bottom of the seventh to pull away from the Cardinals. At Williams, the Bantams edged the host Ephs 8-3 as junior pitcher Jeremiah Bayer limited Williams to three runs on five hits while going the distance. The loss put Williams up against Tufts for the right to play on Sunday, however the game was suspended in the top of the seventh due to lightning and heavy rains, forcing the contest to finish on Sunday morning. Tufts eventually came away with the win, 15-9. Sunday morning, Tufts opened up a 3-0 after six innings before Trinity slowly began to chip away at the deficit. The Bantams took the lead for good with a five-run eighth, capped by senior Sean Killeen's grand slam. Trinity went on to win 7-3. Killeen set or tied four Bantam career records in the final two tournament games, including three on Sunday. He now has the program career records for at-bats (538), runs (176), hits (213), and is tied for first all-time in RBI (155). Killeen also is the all-time leader in triples (10) and walks (93).... Trinity will begin its national title defense on Wednesday during the 2009 NCAA New England Regional hosted by Eastern Conn. St. when the Bantams face Westfield St. The Owls (23-15) won the MASCAC title on May 3. Trinity took two from Westfield St. over the Bantam's spring break trip on March 19...Hamilton junior pitcher Max Foster (Sherborn, Mass.) struck out five Cortland St. batters on Tuesday, tying the team record for strikeouts in a season with 62 in a 7-0 loss to the Red Dragons. James Harrison finished the 2002 season with 62 strikeouts to establish the program record...Tufts sophomore OF Chase Rose (Scottsdale, Ariz) hit .450 (9-for-20) with five runs scored and four RBI while junior 1B Nate Bankoff (Lynnfield, Mass.) batted .400 (8-for-20) with five runs and five RBI as the Jumbos advanced to Sunday's championship before falling to Trinity...Wesleyan senior Garrett Lamborn (Stevenson, Md.) led the Cardinals at the plate during the 2009 NESCAC Baseball Championship, going 4-for-6 (.667) with four runs and five RBI. Lamborn hit his fifth home run of the year on Saturday against Tufts to tie for the team lead. Senior Drew Dominguez (Braintree, Mass.) closed out his career with a program-record 60 hits this season, accumulating 174 over his four-year career to rank second all-time at Wesleyan.
