## Offensive Co-Player of the Week

### Mark Snickenberger, Hamilton

(Sophomore, RB - Wellesley, Mass.) Snickenberger tied a program record with four short yardage rushing touchdowns as the Continentals posted a 28-17 win over Bowdoin on Saturday. He finished the game with 99 yards on 21 carries, a 4.7 yard average per carry.

### Eric McGrath, Trinity

(Senior, QB - Lynn, Mass.)

McGrath set new school records for completions, passing yards, and total offense as he was 34-for-57 for 470 yards and four touchdowns in the Bantams 28-27 overtime win over Tufts. With time winding down in the fourth quarter, McGrath orchestrated the game-tying drive starting from the Trinity eight-yard line, a drive that included two passes on fourth down for a first down.

## Defensive Player of the Week

### Eric Pender, Amherst

(Junior, DL - Drexel Hill, Pa.)

Pender led the Lord Jeffs' defense in a 23-2 win on Saturday. He tied for the team lead in the game with a season-high 10 tackles (three solo), including three sacks for a combined loss of 30 yards. Colby entered the game ranked second in the conference in rushing, averaging 174.3 yards, however the Amherst defense held the Mules to just 51 yards on the ground.

## Special Teams Player of the Week

### Chris Helsel, Wesleyan

(Senior, PK/P - Ridgewood, N.J.)

Handling all of the Cardinals' kicking duties in a 35-8 win at Bates, Helsel went 5-for-5 on PAT attempts, lofted three punts for a 46.7-yard average, two of which pinned Bates inside its own 10-yard line, and sent six kick-offs to an average starting point of the Bates 12-yard line.

**Notes:** Amherst sophomore QB Alex Vetras (Clyde Hill, Wash.) completed 18-of-30 passes for a career-high 271 yards along with two touchdowns in the Jeffs' 23-2 win over Colby. He finished the contest with a pass efficiency rating of 157.88. Junior PK/P Matt Eberhart (Plano, Texas) converted the lone field goal attempt of Saturday's win over Colby from 39 yards out, making him a perfect 3-for-3 on the year...Bates junior RB Judd Smith (Milton, Mass.) rushed for a season-high 59 yards on 14 carries (4.21 yards per carry), all in the second half, and had a two-yard touchdown run in the Bobcats' 35-8 loss to Wesleyan on Saturday. Sophomore OLB Myles Walker (Needham, Mass.) had a game-high eight tackles (seven solo) in the setback. Walker leads his team with 34 tackles (24 solo) so far this season. Junior CB/KR Bill Jennings (Marshfield, Mass.), who entered the weekend leading the conference in kickoff return yards, returned five kicks for 121 yards (24.2 average) in addition to making three solo tackles at cornerback...Bowdoin QB Oliver Kell (Westford, Mass.) moved into a tie for fifth place all-time at Bowdoin (17) with two touchdown tosses at Hamilton on Saturday. Senior LB Damon Hall-Jones (Milton, Mass.) collected the most sacks in a game by a Bowdoin player in a decade, totaling three sacks in the loss...Hamilton junior LB Brian O'Malley (Oak Brook, Ill.) was credited with a career-high nine tackles (six solo) in the Continentals' 28-17 victory over Bowdoin on Saturday. O'Malley helped lead a defense that limited the Polar Bears to 88 yards rushing...Middlebury set new school records for most first downs (37), most passing yards (462), and had its second-highest offensive output in school history (594 yards) in Saturday's 50-45 loss at Williams. Sophomore QB Donald McKillop (Poway, Calif.) set school records for completions (47), passing yards (462) and total offense (506) in the game...Trinity junior DE Kyle Williams (Bethesda, Md.) had 10 tackles, 1.5 sacks, and 2.5 tackles for a loss in the Bantams' 28-27 overtime win over Tufts...Tufts senior RB Will Forde (Hyde Park, Mass.) had his fourth consecutive 100-yard rushing day for the Jumbos, gaining 101 yards on 31 carries (3.26 yards per carry) and scored two touchdowns in the Jumbos' overtime loss at Trinity. Junior safety Tom Tassinari (North Andover, Mass.) had 14 tackles, 11 of which were solo, in the contest...Wesleyan freshman RB Vince Miller (Pittsburgh, Pa.) carried the ball eight times for 80 yards (10.0 yards per carry) and scored a touchdown on a 23-yard rush in the second quarter to help the Cardinals post a 35-8 win at Bates. Wesleyan scored on five of its first seven possessions for a 35-0 lead early in the second half. Rookie Greg McDonough (Merrimack, N.H.) scored two touchdowns on short runs...Williams junior WR Nick Caro (Andover, Mass.) made seven receptions for a school-record 218 yards and two touchdowns to help the Ephs post a 50-45 win over Middlebury. Caro's touchdown catches were for 49 and 56 yards. Sophomore LB Pat Barren (Worthington, Ohio) made nine tackles (four solo) along with two interceptions in his first start at linebacker after moving from safety.
