## Offensive Player of the Week

### **Oliver Starnes, Trinity**

(Junior, RB - Ledgewood, N.J.)

Starnes rushed 19 times for 116 yards (6.11 yards per carry) and scored three touchdowns in the Bantams' 30-13 victory over Amherst on Saturday. His touchdown runs went for one, 12 and 69 yards, and he also caught three passes for 26 yards. The win secured Trinity its fifth NESCAC title in the last seven years.

## Defensive Player of the Week

### **Tyler Berry, Trinity**

(Senior, LB - East Lyme, Conn.)

Berry tied the mark for most tackles in Saturday's game against Amherst with nine (four solo) while recording a tackle for a loss of six yards, a half sack, a pass break-up, and two interceptions. One of Berry's two interceptions came on the Bantams' goal line to stop an Amherst scoring drive.

## Special Teams Player of the Week

### **Nolan McNair, Bowdoin**

(Senior, K/P - Oak Park, Calif.)

McNair was perfect for the Polar Bears in their 55-14 win over Bates on Saturday. McNair went 7-for-7 on PAT attempts and was 2-for-2 in field goals, hitting from 20 and 32 yards out in the win. He also placed both of his punts on the afternoon inside the Bates 20 yard line.

**Notes:** With a win over Amherst on Saturday, Trinity secured the NESCAC Football Championship for 2008. The title is the fifth for the Bantams in the last seven years.

The winner of Saturday's Williams-Amherst game will finish as runner-up to Trinity...**Amherst** senior WR Jim Eckenrode (Madison, Conn.) caught six passes for a career-high 11 yards and one touchdown in the Jeffs' setback at Trinity on Saturday. Sophomore QB Alex Vetrus (Clyde Hill, Wash.) completed 28-of-43 passes for 283 yards and two touchdowns. Senior OLB Guy Matisis (Hingham, Mass.) had a team-high seven tackles (six solo) in the game. Sophomore RB/RS Femi Oyalowo (Bowie, Md.) returned two kickoffs for 32 and 28 yards...**Bates** junior WR/QB Tom Beaton (West Newbury, Mass.) rushed for a team-high 31 yards and a touchdown, completed 3-of-3 passes for 19 yards, and caught three passes for 14 yards. Sophomore OLB Myles Walker (Needham, Mass.) made 11 tackles (nine solo) and one for a loss at Bowdoin. He leads the Bobcats with 57 in his first season as a starter. Junior CB/PR Bill Jennings (Marshfield, Mass.) returned 10 kickoffs for 210 yards. He ranks second in the NESCAC in kickoff return average at 23.2 yards per return...**Bowdoin** junior QB Oliver Kell (Westford, Mass.) totaled 346 yards of total offense, rushing for 92 yards and one touchdown while passing for 254 yards and a score in the Polar Bears 55-14 win over Bates. The touchdown pass moved Kell into fourth place all-time at Bowdoin (19). The 55 points were the most for the Polar Bears since 1951, as the offense racked up 595 total yards. Junior LB Kevin Zikaras (Milford, Conn.) made six solo tackles, including one for a loss, and picked off a pass in the third quarter which he returned 75 yards for a touchdown, the longest interception return in school history...**Colby** senior DB Chris Copeland (Rexford, N.Y.) had a team-high 13 tackles, a fumble recovery, two pass break-ups, and a quarterback hurry in the Mules' 17-10 loss at Tufts. His fumble recovery set up Colby's lone touchdown of the day. Senior P/K Victor Gagne (Norridgewock, Maine) averaged 41.5 yards on six punts, placing three inside the 20 yard line and recording a long of 61 yards. He was also 1-for-1 on PAT and 1-for-2 on field goal attempts...**Hamilton** freshman QB Jordan Eck (Rye, N.Y.) went 21-for-47 for 209 yards and a season-high three touchdowns without an interception in the Continentals' 31-28 loss to Middlebury. Junior LB John Lawrence (Baldwinsville, N.Y.) was credited with a game-high 11 tackles, including 1.5 for a total loss of two yards, broke up two passes and recorded his sixth interception of the season. Lawrence has now picked off a pass in six straight games. Hamilton limited Middlebury 29 yards on 25 carries...**Middlebury** junior QB Jack Kramer (Brattleboro, Vt.) went 22-for-44 for 361 yards and three touchdowns in his first career start at Hamilton on Saturday. Kramer also scored a rushing touchdown in the 31-28 win, as he led the Panthers on the game-winning drive with less than a minute remaining in the game. Tyler Owens and Dan Haluska made nine tackles each in the victory. Sophomore kicker Anthony Kuchan (Wauwatosa, Wis.) gave the Panthers their only lead of Saturday's game, as his 33-yard field goal with 11 seconds remaining lifted Middlebury past Hamilton. Kuchan is now 5-for-5 on the season...**Tufts** senior WR David Halas (Southbury, Conn.) caught two touchdowns from two different quarterbacks to lead the Jumbos to a 17-10 victory over Colby. He finished the game with seven receptions for 101 yards. Halas extended his Tufts single-season and career touchdown reception records to 10 and 18, respectively. Senior LB Tyson Reynoso (Bellevue, Idaho) had a team-high 10 tackles and sealed the win with his first career interception...**Wesleyan** senior K/P Chris Helsel (Ridgewood, N.J.) saw time as a receiver at Williams on Saturday, making eight catches for 72 yards including his first career touchdown. He entered the contest with 10 career receptions, none this season...**Williams** senior RB Brian Morrissey (Winchester, Mass.) gained 138 yards on the ground and scored three touchdowns in a 48-14 win over Wesleyan on Saturday. He also added two catches for 29 yards. He is 91 yards short of his first 1,000-yard season. QB Patrick Moffitt (Turnersville, N.J.) completed 18-of-24 passes for 222 yards and one touchdown in the win. Senior DT Charlie Birns (Scarsdale, N.Y.) made four tackles, including his league-leading seventh sack as part of two tackles for a loss, and also registered a quarterback hurry in the Ephs' win. Junior PK Scott Sobolewski (Clifton Park, N.J.) went 2-for-2 in field goal tries, including a career-long 43 yarder, and was 6-for-6 on extra point attempts.
