Offensive Co-Players of the Week

Oliver Kell, Bowdoin

(Senior, QB - Westford, Mass.)

Kell completed 25-of-42 passes for 374 yards and four touchdowns with no interceptions (165.8 rating) in the Polar Bears' 50-35 win against Middlebury. It was the second-most touchdowns and yards in a game in program history. Additionally, Kell also became Bowdoin's all-time leader in career passing yards as he eclipsed the 4,000 yard mark (4,086).

Pat Noone, Bowdoin

(Sophomore, WR - N. Attleboro, Mass.)

In his first career start, Noone caught a school-record 12 receptions for 180 yards, the second most yardage by a receiver in program history. He scored Bowdoin's first touchdown of the day on a five-yard end-around before catching passes of 51 and 58 yards for touchdowns.

Defensive Player of the Week

Walter Fallas, Trinity

(Sophomore, ILB - Everett, Mass.)

Fallas made a game- and career-high 18 tackles (seven solo) to anchor a Bantam defense that held Bates to 30 rushing yards on 29 attempts in Saturday's 35-14 win in Lewiston, Maine. Fallas also had an interception and two tackles for a loss of four yards as Trinity won its 11th straight game along with their 16th in a row over the Bobcats.

Special Teams Player of the Week

Grant Kunkel, Trinity

(Senior, P - New Canaan, Conn.)

Kunkel averaged 44.4 yards per attempt on five punts, including a long of 51 yards and two punts which landed inside the 20-yard line during the Bantams' 35-14 win at Bates on Saturday.

Notes: Amherst junior QB Alex Vetras (Clyde Hill, Wash.) matched a career-high for touchdowns in a contest with three touchdown tosses in Saturday's 21-12 win at Hamilton. Vetras was 23-of-44 for 273 yards and no interceptions. Senior DL Edwin Urey (Quincy, Mass.) made eight tackles (four solo), including 4.5 tackles for a loss and four sacks for a loss of 28 yards. He also added a pass break-up in the win. Junior WR/KR Andre Gary (Exeter, N.H.) returned five punts and one kickoff for a total of 60 yards, running back the lone kickoff return 41 yards...Bates senior WR Tom Beaton (West Newbury, Mass.) had a game-high 136 all-purpose yards in a 35-14 setback to Trinity on Saturday. Beaton had seven catches for 87 yards along with a three-yard touchdown run. Sophomore OLB Brett McAllister (Exeter, N.H.) tied for the team lead with 10 tackles (seven solo) in his first career start, recovering three Trinity fumbles. Junior K/P Gavin Segall-Abrams (Greensboro, N.C.) connected on both of his PAT attempts, averaged 35.1 yards on eight punts, and also forced a fumble...Bowdoin senior LB Kevin Zikaras (Milford, Conn.) led the Polar Bears with 15 total tackles on Saturday against Middlebury (nine solo), contributing three stops for a loss and an interception in the fourth quarter to seal the win...Hamilton freshman QB Dan Peters (Niskayuna, N.Y.) completed 18 passes for 207 yards (18-for-38) and one touchdown in his first collegiate start. Senior DE Landrey Mack (Weedsport, N.Y.) recorded the first two sacks of his career in the setback to Amherst on Saturday. Mack finished the contest with a total of four tackles, as he helped limit the Jeffs to 37 rushing yards on 30 attempts. Junior K/P George Taylor (Pleasantville, N.Y.) averaged 37 yards on nine punts, with his longest going for 58 yards. Two of Taylor's punts pinned Amherst inside their own 20-yard line...Middlebury junior QB Donald McKillop (Poway, Calif.) completed 38-of-61 passes for 420 yards with three touchdowns and three interceptions on Saturday in a 50-35 loss at Bowdoin. Matt Rayner (Andover, Mass.) and David Reed (New Canaan, Conn.) each caught seven passes for 101 yards, with McKillop and Rayner hooking up for all three Panther touchdown tosses. LB Chris Dola (Arlington, Va.) made five tackles, 3.5 for a loss, and had 1.5 sacks for the Panthers...Trinity senior WR Winston Tuggle (Canton, Mass.) caught three passes for 115 yards, including a 71-yard touchdown strike in the Bantams' 35-14 victory at Bates on Saturday...Tufts junior Pat Bailey (Beverly, Mass.) had 129 all-purpose yards for the Jumbos at Wesleyan on Saturday, with 52 yards receiving, 32 on punt returns, 29 rushing and 16 on kickoff returns. Junior LB Matt Murray (Winthrop, Mass.) led the Jumbos with 10 tackles...Wesleyan sophomore RB Vince Miller (Pittsburgh, Pa.) posted the second 100-yard rushing game of his career as he carried the ball 23 times for 102 yards in the Cardinals 7-3 win against Tufts. Senior Shea Dwyer (Marlborough, Conn.) added 69 yards on 14 attempts and scored the game's only touchdown on a five-yard run in the second quarter. Junior DB Justin Freres (Santa Barbara, Calif.) paced Wesleyan's defense with nine tackles against Tufts, including a big stop for no gain on a 4th-and-1 run by the Jumbos at the Wesleyan 20-yard line. He also recorded a sack for a loss of eight yards...Williams sophomore QB Matt Coyne (Bristol, Conn.) rushed for two touchdowns on Saturday at Colby, including a 16-yard scramble into the end zone with one minute remaining to give the Ephs a 23-19 win over Colby. He finished the day with 37 yards on five carries while completing 6-of-7 passes for 36 yards. Senior CB Matt Zanedis (Upper Saddle River, N.J.) had three tackles in Saturday's game. He also contributed a pass break-up, a fumble recovery and return for 32 yards for a touchdown.
