## Offensive Player of the Week

### Michael Galligan, Trinity

(Junior, WR - Shoreham, N.Y.)

Galligan played a big part in the Bantams' 26-21 come-from-behind victory over Williams on Saturday, as he caught nine passes for 97 yards along with two touchdowns - including the game-winner. Galligan's first touchdown of the day came with 1:43 remaining in the game to pull Trinity within two. He hauled in his second touchdown with 14 seconds left in the game for the win.

## Defensive Co-Players of the Week

### Mike Taylor, Amherst

(Senior, LB - Evanston, Ill.)

Taylor led the Lord Jeff defense with 16 total tackles (seven solo) in Amherst's 13-12 come-from-behind win over Bowdoin on Saturday. Taylor also had 3.0 tackles for a loss and sack for a loss of eight yards.

### Harry Melendez, Trinity

(Junior, CB - Holyoke, Mass.)

Melendez had two interceptions, the first coming in the first half which he returned 47 yards for a touchdown before grabbing the second at the end of the game to seal a 26-21 win over Williams. He also had three tackles and a pass break-up.

## Special Teams Player of the Week

### Bill Donahue, Bowdoin

(Junior, P/K - East Walpole, Mass.)

Donahue tied a program record as he connected on all four of his field goal tries and accounted for all of the Polar Bears' 12 points in a 13-12 setback at Amherst on Saturday. Donahue battled heavy rains as he nailed attempts from 29, 22, 23, and 19 yards to give Bowdoin a 12-6 lead late in the fourth quarter. He also had three punts for an average of 31.7 yards.

**Notes:** Amherst senior WR Brandon Bullock (West Orange, N.J.) led the Lord Jeffs receivers with six receptions for 62 yards in a 13-12 win over Bowdoin. Bullock grabbed the game-winning touchdown with less than three minutes remaining in the fourth quarter. Senior punter Matt Eberhart (Plano, Texas) kicked eight punts, averaging 37.8 yards per punt with a long of 45 yards...Bates senior WR/QB Tom Beaton (West Newbury, Mass.) totaled 144 all-purpose yards, including a career-high 63 rushing yards on eight attempts in a 15-7 loss to Tufts. He also returned two kickoffs for a total of 54 yards. Junior LB Myles Walker (Needham, Mass.) had a game-high 12 tackles (11 solo), including three tackles for a loss...Bowdoin sophomore WR Pat Noone (North Attleboro, Mass.) became the first Polar Bear to post consecutive 100-yard receiving games since 2005 with nine catches and 125 yards at Amherst on Saturday...Hamilton junior QB Lance Wilson (Plymouth Meeting, Pa.) made his first collegiate appearance midway through the second quarter of Saturday's contest against Wesleyan. Wilson finished the game 22-of-32 passing for 208 yards and three touchdowns with one interception (122.16 rating). The Continentals trailed 14-0 in the second when Wilson first stepped on the field, however he led the Continentals to a 26-14 come-from-behind victory. Senior LB John Lawrence (Baldwinsville, N.Y.) was credited with a game-high 11 tackles (five solo), including a sack for a loss of eight yards. Lawrence led an effort that limited Wesleyan to 109 yards of offense in the second half. Sophomore DB Ted Finan (New Canaan, Conn.) recovered a muffed punt midway through the fourth quarter which led to Hamilton's fourth and final touchdown. He also returned a punt for 12 yards...Middlebury junior QB Donald McKillop (Poway, Calif.) had a huge day for the Panthers in a 45-0 win against Colby on Saturday, completing 33-of-42 passes for 364 yards and three touchdowns. McKillop hit 10 different receivers in the win. Junior LB Andrew Poulin (Irvington, N.Y.) helped lead the Panther defense to a shutout of the Mules, accumulating 10 tackles (seven solo) along with 3.0 tackles for a loss of 13 yards. He also recorded one sack for a seven yard loss...Trinity sophomore kicker Tim Costello (Solana Beach, Calif.) kicked field goals of 23 and 31 yards and also executed a perfect onside kick in the final minute which the Bantams recovered to set up the game-winning drive...Tufts junior RB Pat Bailey (Beverly, Mass.) was the Jumbos' leading rusher and receiver in a 15-7 victory at Bates. Bailey carried the ball 18 times for 67 yards (3.72 yards per carry) while making four catches for 89 yards, including a 71-yard touchdown in the fourth quarter that gave the Jumbos a 15-7 advantage. He also returned five punts for 24 yards and a kickoff for 21 yards, as he totaled 197 all-purpose yards. Junior LB Matt Murray (Winthrop, Mass.) made 11 tackles (nine solo) to lead the Jumbos defense for the second-straight week. He had a nine-yard sack in the second quarter. The Tufts defense did not allow a touchdown in the game and held Bates to 3-of-15 on third down. Sophomore kicker Adam Auerbach (Glen Rock, N.J.) gave the Jumbos an early lead in the contest with a 35-yard field goal...Wesleyan senior RB Shea Dwyer ran 60 yards for a touchdown on the second play from scrimmage on Saturday at Hamilton. It was the longest run by a Cardinal running back in 51 games. Sophomore LB Cyprian Oyomba had eight tackles for the Cardinals (four solo), including three sacks for a loss of 15 yards. He also caused a fumble, as the Cardinals held Hamilton to 18 rushing yards on 33 attempts...Williams junior RB Ryan Lupo (Princeton Jct., N.J.) carried the ball 29 times for 125 yards (4.3 yards per carry) in the Ephs 26-21 setback at Trinity. He also caught one pass for 10 yards. Sophomore LB Dylan Schultz (Williamstown, Mass.) made nine tackles on Saturday (seven solo), with two for a loss and one sack. He also had a pass break-up in the game. Senior punter Will Cronin (Acton, Mass.) punted seven times for an average of 40.6 yards per punt and a long of 48 yards. Three of Cronin's seven punts pinned the Bantams inside their own 20-yard line.
