Offensive Player of the Week

Michael Galligan, Trinity

(Junior, WR - Shoreham, N.Y.)

Galligan caught eight passes for 165 yards and three touchdowns in a 45-31 shootout victory for Trinity over Bowdoin on Saturday afternoon. His 20-yard touchdown reception with 8:05 remaining in the fourth quarter proved to be the game-winner, as he also scored on 22 and 35-yard touchdown catches. The Bantams have won 15 straight games and 34 in a row at home.

Defensive Player of the Week

Peter Scheve, Colby

(Senior, DT - Baltimore, Md.)

Scheve recorded five tackles (three solo), two sacks - one of which resulted in a safety - and recovered a fumble in the Mules' 16-0 road victory at Hamilton on Saturday. Colby recorded its first road shutout since 2002 as the defense limited Hamilton to 87 total yards and -14 yards rushing in the game. His two sacks were for a combined loss of seven yards.

Special Teams Player of the Week

Will Cronin, Williams

(Senior, P/DB - Acton, Mass.)

Cronin averaged 37.2 yards per punt over four punts as the Ephs came away with a 30-7 victory against Tufts on Saturday. Cronin had a long of 42 yards and pinned the Jumbos inside the 20-yard line once. He also recorded one solo tackle in the win.

Notes: Amherst senior RB Aaron Rauh (Hudson, Ohio) ran for two touchdowns during a 23-0 victory over Wesleyan. Rauh carried the ball 14 times for 46 yards (3.3 yards per carry), scoring his two touchdowns in the fourth quarter. Senior safety Fred Argir (Lakeville, Minn.) had two interceptions, both of which led to Lord Jeff touchdowns, and added five tackles (four solo) and a pass break-up. He leads Amherst in interceptions (5) and pass break-ups (8) and is third on the team in tackles (38). The Lord Jeffs have not allowed more than 13 points in each of their first five outings. Senior punter Matt Eberhart (Plano, Texas) averaged 28.4 yards per punt over five punts during the win, placing three of his punts inside the 20-yard line...

Bates freshman RB Patrick George (Gloucester, Mass.) had 20 carries for 61 yards and a touchdown, plus another touchdown on an 18-yard pass from Tom Beaton in a 28-18 setback to Middlebury. Junior OLB Myles Walker (Needham, Mass.) made a team-high 13 tackles (eight solo) and also forced a fumble against the Panthers. Walker leads the Bobcats with 47 tackles this season (34 solo)...**Bowdoin** senior QB Oliver Kell (Westford, Mass.) completed 28-of-48 passes for 358 yards and four touchdowns as the Polar Bears fell short at Trinity, 45-31. Kell tied the program's single-season record with his 12th touchdown pass of the season and also broke the Polar Bears' career passing touchdowns mark during the contest (32)...**Colby** junior WR Patrick Burns (Charles Town, W. Va.) had a career-best 119 yards along with a touchdown during a 16-0 victory at Hamilton on Saturday. His touchdown reception came during a 64-yard catch-and-run on the first play of a drive in the third quarter. Burns leads the Mules in receiving yards (254), yards per game (50.8), and yards per catch (18.1)...**Hamilton** senior LB John Lawrence (Baldwinsville, N.Y.) was credited with a career-high 16 tackles (nine solo), including 1.5 for a combined loss of five yards. He also broke up a pass in the game...**Middlebury** senior QB Donald McKillop (Poway, Calif.) completed 23-of-43 passes for 252 yards in a 28-18 win at Bates. McKillop tossed touchdowns of 15, 24, and 26 yards while also rushing for 48 yards. He also became the program's all-time leader in pass attempts, now with 749...**Trinity** senior OLB Kyle Williams (Bethesda, Md.) recorded 10 tackles (eight solo), 1.5 sacks and 3.5 tackles for a loss in the Bantams' 45-31 win against Bowdoin...**Tufts** junior Michael Durkin (Eden Prairie, Minn.) led the Jumbos with 43 yards rushing and returned four kickoffs for 77 yards while seeing the most action of his collegiate career in a 30-7 loss at Williams. Senior safety Alex Pery (Danvers, Mass.) had nine tackles (seven solo), including a nine-yard sack in the setback...**Wesleyan** sophomore DB Cam Davilla (Yorba Linda, Calif.) made two interceptions during Saturday's 23-0 loss at Amherst. Junior DE A.J. Chan (Danville, Calif.) collected a career-high 10 tackles (four solo), including two behind the line of scrimmage in the first half...

Williams junior WR/RB Bryce Bennett (Jonesboro, Ark.) had two rushes for 14 yards, seven catches for 67 yards, a kickoff return for 31 yards, and two touchdowns in a 30-7 win over Tufts. Freshman LB Chris Cameron (Walpole, Mass.) made five tackles (two solo) in the victory, three going for losses of 21 yards and two sacks for a combined 18 yards.
