Field Hockey Player of the Week

Christy Bradley, Trinity

(Junior, Forward - Wellesley, Mass.)

Bradley had both of the Bantams goals during a 2-1 overtime win at Tufts in a battle between undefeated teams on Saturday afternoon. Bradley's first goal tied the contest at one-all in the 44th minute before her second tally gave Trinity the win eight minutes into overtime. She currently ranks third in the conference in overall points with 25 and goals with 11.

Notes: Plenty of questions still need to be answered before the start of the 2009 NESCAC Field Hockey Championship on Sunday, Nov. 1. Trinity's 2-1 overtime victory at Tufts on Saturday means that the Bantams are the only team remaining in the conference with an undefeated record.

The Bantams can move a step closer to earning the top seed in this year's tournament with a win over Bowdoin on Saturday. Last year, Trinity was one of only two teams to hand the Polar Bears a loss in the regular season, 2-0 in Brunswick. Trinity is also the only team that has secured a home game in this year's quarterfinals, as it will be the first time the Bantams have ever hosted a first round contest in playoff history. Championship position will be on the line for numerous teams this weekend. Of note will be the matchup between second-place Tufts at third-place Williams on Saturday...**Amherst** first year forward Katie McMahon (Denville, N.J.) collected three goals and two assists during a 2-0 week for the Jeffs. McMahon had two goals and an assist in a 6-0 win over Westfield St. on Tuesday, followed by a goal and an assist in a 4-1 win at Colby on Saturday...**Bates** junior goalkeeper Katie McEnroe (Hockessin, Del.) made 12 saves during a 3-1 setback at Wesleyan on Saturday...**Bowdoin** junior forward Jessie Small (Wayne, Pa.) had the game's only goal during a 1-0 win over Williams on Saturday. Earlier in the week, Small netted two goals and an assist in a 10-0 win against Maine-Farmington on Thursday...**Colby's** Meghan Saccone scored two goals in a 4-1 over Thomas on Wednesday. Saccone is tied for second in scoring for the Mules with four goals and two assists...**Connecticut College** sophomore midfielder Kelly Watkins (San Jose, Calif.) contributed an assist in a 4-1 loss at Middlebury on Saturday...**Middlebury's** Chase Delano (Greenwich, Conn.) and Heather McCormack (Rowley, Mass.) each earned two goals and an assist during a 2-0 week for the Panthers...**Tufts** junior Tamara Brown (Annandale, Va.) broke the program record for goals in a career with a hat trick against Connecticut College on Wednesday. She now has 46 career goals, surpassing Aryn Landau's total of 44 from 1987-90...**Wesleyan** sophomore forward Morgan McCauley (Rye, N.Y.) paced the Cardinals to a 3-1 victory against Bates with two goals. Her first goal came just 3:18 into the contest. She improved her team-leading points totals to eight goals and three assists...**Williams** junior goalkeeper Katrina Tulla (New Canaan, Conn.) combined for 17 saves during two one-goal losses last week. Tulla made eight saves in a 3-2 setback to Hamilton on Thursday, then turned aside nine shots in a 1-0 loss at Bowdoin. For the week, Tulla stopped .810 of the shots she faced.
