Men's Soccer Co-Players of the Week

Lennard Kovacs, Amherst

(Sophomore, GK - Wolfersdorf, Germany)
 Kovacs posted back-to-back shutouts during a 2-0 week for the Lord Jeffs, as he finished the week with 20 saves over 180 minutes of play. On Wednesday against Framingham St., Kovacs stopped seven shots in a 1-0 victory. He followed on Saturday against Middlebury with four saves in a 3-0 victory. Kovacs now has five shutouts through eight outings this season.

Peter Marlette, Trinity

(Junior, Midfielder - Buffalo, N.Y.)
 Marlette had four goals for the Bantams during a 3-0 week that included big conference victories over Connecticut College and Williams. Marlette started the week with a goal in a 5-1 win over Westfield St. on Wednesday, then provided both Trinity tallies in a 2-1 victory against Connecticut College on Saturday. He capped the week with the game's final goal in a 3-0 win at previously-unbeaten Williams on Sunday.

Notes: Only three weeks remain before the start of the **2009 NESCAC Men's Soccer Championship**. The top eight teams in the conference at the completion of the regular season qualify for the tournament, with the top four seeds earning the right to host quarterfinal matches on Sunday, Nov. 1. The conference title has gone to four different teams over the past four years, and three of those squads - Amherst (2008), Wesleyan (2005) and Williams (2006) - currently rank among the top four in the league standings. Colby hopes to earn its first-ever berth into the NESCAC championship this season, as the Mules currently occupy eighth...**Bates** freshman forward Ethan Hirshberg (Concord, N.H.) netted the Bobcats' lone goal in a 1-1 draw at Southern Maine on Wednesday. Over the past six outings, Hirshberg leads Bates in scoring with two goals and an assist...**Bowdoin** junior goalkeeper Dan Hicks (New York, N.Y.) made a pair of saves as the Polar Bears played Wesleyan to a scoreless draw on Saturday. Bowdoin has allowed one goal over its last seven games...**Colby** freshman midfielder Nick Aubin (Simsbury, Conn.) had two goals, including the game-winning tally in overtime, in the Mules' 3-2 win at Tufts on Saturday. Aubin leads Colby in scoring with three goals this season...**Connecticut College** freshman defender Graham Christensen (Darien, Conn.) netted the tying goal during the 90th minute of play of Wednesday's 1-1 draw with Babson...**Tufts** senior Bear Duker (Newton, Mass.) scored with 1:49 remaining in regulation to force overtime in Saturday's 3-2 overtime setback to Colby. It was the fifth overtime game this fall for the Jumbos. Duker also had the team's lone goal in a 2-1 loss at Plymouth St. on Wednesday...**Wesleyan** freshman goalkeeper Adam Purdy (Montclair, N.J.) played 188 scoreless minutes in net for the Cardinals as he upped his shutout total to five during a 1-0-1 week. Purdy made three saves in 78 minutes against Coast Guard during a 3-0 win on Tuesday, then made six stops in a scoreless draw with Bowdoin on Saturday. The Cardinals have equaled their second-best start in program history and have allowed the fewest goals (three) ever after nine games...**Williams** junior forward Charles Romero (Mansfield, Mass.) had three goals and an assist in a 2-1 week for the Ephs. Romero had two goals and an assist in Saturday's 4-0 win over Bates. He leads the Ephs with seven goals and 16 points so far this season.
