MIDDLEBURY WOMEN'S ICE HOCKEY TO HOST NCAA FINAL FOUR

For the first time in school history, Middlebury has advanced to the NCAA semifinals. The Panthers did so by defeating two-time defending NCAA Champion Elmira, 2-1 at the Kenyon Arena. Middlebury will take on Plattsburgh when they host the NCAA semifinals and championship next Friday and Saturday at the Kenyon Arena. Manhattanville will meet Wisconsin-Stevens Point in the other semifinal.

Middlebury opened the scoring at 6:39 as Liz Yale-Loehr made a centering pass from the left wing to a wide-open Lindsay Jones. Jones cut to the goal and beat Edith Racine with a shot to the right side driving to the net. Lorna Gifis made it a 2-0 lead for Middlebury with a power play goal at 15:58 of the first period. Cutting to the goal from the right side, Gifis snapped a shot that was saved by Racine before she put home her own rebound.

Middlebury held a decisive 13-4 shots advantage in the second period, but were unable to capitalize. Their best chances may have come during a five-minute major at 13:27, but the Panthers were only able to muster up three shots.

Elmira cut the lead in half at 12:13 of the third period with a power play goal from Laura Hurd. The Soaring Eagles leading goal scorer broke through the pack and skated through the slot before backhanding a shot into the top right corner of the net. Elmira threatened late in the game, but could not score the equalizer in the game's final minutes.

Kate Kogut made 17 saves in goal for the Panthers, while Racine made 22 stops for Elmira.

BOWDOIN FALLS TO PLATTSBURGH 2-1 IN NCAA FIRST ROUND

PLATTSBURGH, N.Y. - Junior Erin O'Brien scored midway through the second period to give the Plattsburgh State a 2-1 lead that would hold up the rest of the game as the Cardinals defeated Bowdoin in Plattsburgh to advance to the NCAA Division III Tournament Final Four. The Cardinals earn a semifinal matchup with Middlebury College. Bowdoin concludes one of the best seasons in school history with a record of 20-5-1.

The Polar Bears have reached the 20-win plateau in each of the past three seasons and have qualified for the NCAA Tournament in all three years of the tourney's existence. Bowdoin's senior class of Britney Carr, Jess Burke, Jen Pelkey with captains Sadie Wieschhoff and Gillian McDonald have set a new standard for excellence in the women's ice hockey program, posting a best-ever four-year mark of 82-17-8 including two NESCAC Championships.
