Women's Lacrosse Player of the Week

Rachel Romanowsky, Trinity

(Sophomore, Midfielder - Hampstead, N.H.)

Romanowsky racked up eight goals and five assists for 13 points during a 2-0 week for the Bantams. On Wednesday against Eastern Conn. St., Romanowsky contributed three goals, two assists and four draw controls in a 16-3 victory. She continued over the weekend with five goals and three assists in a 13-12 win at Bowdoin on Saturday.

Notes: Amherst sophomore midfielder Kelley Trapp (Monterey, Calif.) had four goals and three assists during a 2-0 week for the Jeffs, with two of her assists coming on game-winning goals. After posting a goal and two assists in a 10-9 double-overtime victory against Springfield earlier in the week, Trapp scored three times and added an assist in an 8-6 win at Connecticut College on Saturday...Bates senior attacker Caroline Thomas (Barrington, R.I.) led the Bobcats during a 1-1 week with seven goals and one assist. Thomas has 16 goals and two assists through four games this season...Bowdoin first years McKenna Teague (Cohasset, Mass.) and Liz Clegg (Hudson, Ohio) scored three goals each in Saturday's 13-12 setback to Trinity...Colby senior midfielder Kate Sheridan (Hingham, Mass.) had five goals and three assists for eight points over two games last week, as she moved within one point of the Mules' all-time career scoring record. Sheridan has 154 goals and 67 assists for 221 points, needing only one more to tie the mark set by Ally King '03...Connecticut College first year attacker Katelyn Driscoll (Peabody, Mass.) tallied four goals during a 1-1 week for the Camels. Driscoll recorded a hat trick and accounted for the game-winning score in her collegiate debut, a 7-4 win over Roger Williams on Wednesday...Middlebury's Dana Heritage (Cheshire, Conn.) and Sally Ryan (Mountain Lakes, N.J.) each scored three goals during the Panthers' 11-8 victory over Babson on Friday...Tufts junior attacker Emily Johnson (Yarmouth, Maine) collected nine goals and an assist in a 2-0 week for the Jumbos. Johnson had five goals, including three in the final 10:45, in Saturday's 13-9 win at Colby. Earlier in the week she added four goals and an assist along with five ground balls in a 20-3 win against Wellesley...Wesleyan junior midfielder Erin McCarthy (Ridgefield, Conn.) recorded eight points during the Cardinals' 2-1 week, scoring two goals and two assists in a 13-6 win at home against Eastern Conn. St. on Sunday...Williams senior midfielder Britt Spackman (Newton, Mass.) registered 11 points during a 2-0 week for the Ephs. Spackman had two goals and three assists in a come-from-behind 13-9 win at Bates on Saturday, after contributing three goals and three assists in a 17-6 victory against MIT on Thursday. She currently leads Williams in scoring with seven goals and seven assists for 14 points through three games.
