Volleyball Player of the Week

Danielle Isaman, Trinity

(First Year, OH - West Hartford, Conn.)

Isaman averaged 4.7 kills and 3.0 digs per set while hitting at a rate of .315 as the Bantams went 3-0 last week, including victories over Bates and Colby. Tuesday evening at Eastern Conn. St., Isaman had 13 kills and 11 digs in a 3-0 win. At Bates over the weekend, Isaman had 15 kills and six digs in a 3-0 victory against the host Bobcats, followed by a 19-kill, 13-dig performance in a 3-1 win over Colby on Saturday.

Notes: **Amherst** junior setter Katherine Jordan (Los Altos Hills, Calif.) averaged 11.0 assists and 2.25 digs per set during a 2-0 NESCAC weekend against Bates and Colby... **Bates** sophomore MB Olivia Schow (Costa Mesa, Calif.) averaged 2.57 kills per set and led the Bobcats in aces and blocking during a 0-2 NESCAC weekend. Schow leads the 4-2 Bobcats this season in attack percentage (.358)... **Bowdoin's** Gillian Page led the Polar Bears to a mid-week win over Maine rival Colby, as she notched 20 kills, including five in the decisive fifth set... **Connecticut College** senior MB Meg Christman (Wilmington, Del.) averaged 2.11 kills and 1.0 blocks per set while hitting at a .375 rate in a 2-1 week for the Camels. Against Bowdoin on Friday evening, Christman had eight kills and five blocks in the 3-1 victory... **Hamilton** first year OH Amanda Cohen (Port Washington, N.Y.) was named to the Plattsburgh St. Cardinal Classic All-Tournament team over the weekend. In five matches last week, Cohen averaged 2.63 kills, 2.05 digs and 0.42 aces per set. Cohen recorded a season-high 16 kills in a five-set loss to Buffalo St. on Friday evening... **Middlebury's** Jane Handel (Evanstone, Ill.) had 12 kills while senior Natalie DuPre (Louisville, Ky.) collected 12 digs in a 3-0 win over St. Michael's on Friday... **Tufts** junior OH Caitlin Updike (Manhattan Beach, Calif.) averaged 3.3 kills and 2.0 digs per set while hitting at .319 percent during a 3-0 week for the Jumbos. She also added four service aces. In the opening weekend of NESCAC play, Updike combined for 24 kills and 14 digs against Wesleyan and Connecticut College... **Williams** junior setter Emily Avis (Palo Alto, Calif.) averaged 9.7 assists (116 total) and 3.75 digs per set as the Ephs went 1-2 at the Stevens Tournament over the weekend. Avis also had six kills with no errors in 11 chances and two service aces, as she came away with All-Tournament Team honors.
